

Deputy Chief Medical Examiner

Suffolk County is seeking a Deputy Chief Medical Examiner to act in the absence of the Chief Medical Examiner and perform medical-legal work assisting in the administration of the County Medical Examiner's Office.

Responsibilities include reviewing and coordinating the work of medical, laboratory and investigatory personnel; performing post-mortem examinations; evaluating laboratory reports; providing court testimony, and performing related duties, as required.
