

Autopsy Technician 2

<u>Job Summary/Basic Function</u>: The William L. Jenkins Forensic Center in beautiful Johnson City, Tennessee is seeking an Autopsy Technician 2 to assist staff forensic pathologists with the autopsy examination which includes preparing the autopsy suite, necessary paperwork, specimen containers and body for postmortem examination. This position also assists the forensic pathologist with the postmortem examination (moving bodies, photography, taking x-rays, evidence collection/packaging, documenting personal effects and belongings, collecting toxicology specimens, evisceration/weighing of organs, etc.) and restores body following examination, cleaning of work stations and autopsy suite. Performs other related duties as required or assigned.

Under general supervision of the Forensic Operations Administrative Supervisor the Autopsy Technician 2 leads, plans, schedules and oversees the work of Autopsy Technician 1 positions while performing the same and/or more complex duties of those being led. Also assists in quality management of technical procedures.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of human anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, advanced evisceration and evidence collection techniques. Demonstrated supervisory experience. Knowledge of lead work principles. Ability to stand for extended periods of time and perform heavy lifting. Ability to work with decedents in decomposed state and work in malodorous conditions. Ability to keep detailed records including specimen and evidence control and pay meticulous attention to detail when completing documentation. Ability to use an air purifying respirator required by ETSU Health & Safety. Contingent on Grant Funding.

<u>Minimum Qualifications</u>: High School Diploma or equivalent; bachelor's degree in biology, chemistry or forensic science with course work in anatomy and physiology is preferred. Three years (which includes one year experience as a forensic technician at the William L. Jenkins Forensic Center and two years of full time experience assisting pathologists in performing autopsies and evidence collection).
