



MEDICOLEGAL INVESTIGATOR

Beginning January 5, 2015 Rock County will have a Medical Examiner Department instead of the previous Coroner's Office. The new Medical Examiner Department located in Janesville, Wisconsin is seeking individuals to conduct death investigations to determine the cause and manner of death including the gathering of physical evidence, interviewing material witnesses and assisting at autopsies. This position requires any combination of training or experience equivalent to an associate degree in criminal justice, emergency medical services, fire protection or related field and/or two years experience either performing criminal or civil investigations, including the writing of investigative reports. Requires possession of a valid Wisconsin driver's license, and the ability to work nights, weekends, and holidays. Investigators will be required to carry county-issued cell phones and/or pagers for emergency response. The salary range for this position is \$49,611 - \$60,218 and excellent benefits. Both full time and pool positions are available. A Lead Medicolegal Investigator for the Department may be selected from the Medicolegal Investigators in the future. A written exam, background investigation, physical, and psychological testing will be required for qualifying candidates. The position starts January 5, 2015. An American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigation (ABMDI) certification is required within two years of hire.
