Job Summary: The incumbent investigates deaths falling under the jurisdiction of the Division of Forensic Science (DFS). Duties include but are not limited to: scene investigation, reports preparation and lifting/transporting bodies of all weights to DFS facilities in Wilmington, DE and Georgetown, DE. The incumbent interacts professionally with law enforcement, medical facilities or agencies, law enforcement and private physicians and family members. Hours include regularly scheduled duty hours and twelve-hour shift week-end coverage.

Job Requirements: Applicants must have education, training and/or experience demonstrating competence in each of the following areas:

- 1. Six months experience in conducting investigations which includes conducting interviews to obtain confidential information, gathering evidence and documenting findings.
- 2. Six months experience in determining compliance with laws, rules, regulations, standards, policies and procedures.

- 7. Possession of a valid Driver's License (not suspended, revoked or cancelled or disqualified from driving)
